APPLICATION

Send us your application as a mentee and we will invite you to get to know you better.



MATCHING

We will match you with a suitable mentor.



KICK-OFF EVENT

You get to know your mentor and the other mentees.



TANDEM MEETINGS EVERY 4 - 6 WEEKS

You agree with your mentor on how often you meet and what you want to discuss. As a mentee, you specify the topics.



WORKSHOPS

With the other mentees, you will attend a total of 3-4 workshops to deepen your professional knowledge and exchange experiences.



CLOSING EVENT

You receive your certificate of successful participation in the MENTEGRA program in a festive setting.

Requirements for participation

- · Qualification: a degree or professional experience from your country of origin
- Refugee history: You came to Germany as a refugee or a new immigrant in the last few years
- · Legal: residence status with prospects of staying
- · Language level: good German skills
- Motivation: You want to shape your career path in Germany
